## 23<sup>rd</sup> World Congress of Chinese Medicine Conference Announcement (1<sup>st</sup> Round)

October 2026, Singapore

The **World Congress of Chinese Medicine (WCCM)**, organized by the **World Federation of Chinese Medicine Societies (WFCMS)**, is a premier global academic event in the field of Chinese medicine, renowned for its large scale, broad participation, and high level of discourse. To date, 22 successful congresses have been held in: China (2004), France (2005), Canada, Singapore, Macao China, Australia (2009), the Netherlands, the United Kingdom, Malaysia, the United States, Russia, Spain, New Zealand, Thailand, Italy, Hungary, China (2020, online), Hong Kong China, Brazil, the Philippines, France (2024), and Australia (2025).

The 23rd World Congress of Chinese Medicine is scheduled to take place in Singapore in October 2026. The congress will feature diverse forms of academic exchange. Experts, scholars, government officials, and industry representatives from around the world will share theoretical research, clinical experience, scientific achievements, innovations, and inventions.
